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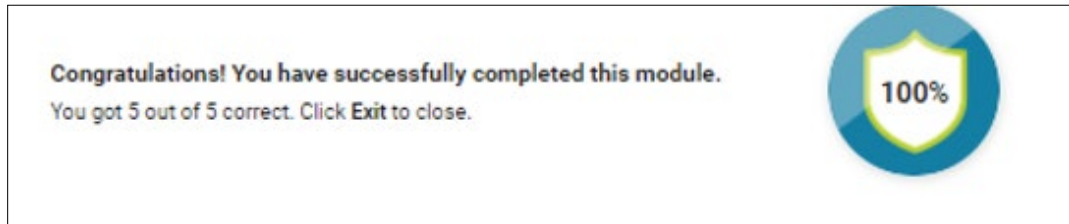
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Step 3: After you click the link, it will open a new web browser window to start the course and display the site below. *No registration or account creation required.*
